

#### About the workshop:

Govt. College, Kosi organised three day workshop on "National Education Policy 2020". This workshop was arranged to serve the awareness of staff members regarding National Education Policy before its implementation in our college and University.

#### Venue & Dates:

The workshop took place on 21-23 June 2022 at the Government College, Kosi. The Organizing team prepared all the arrangements regarding the same in conference hall, in order to meet for fine-tuning of the agenda and coordination of facilitation.

#### Course Content:

- > National Education Policy, 2020 & its implementation.
- > Role of Teachers in the Implementation of NEO, 2020.
- > NAAC Accreditation process and its need for the College.
- > Research in reference to sustainable development.
- > MOOCs- its basics and its role in context to NEP-2020
- > Multiple Entry and Exit in NEP.

#### Training Team & Organizing Team:

The members of the training team were Principal Dr. Sudhir Kumar, Sh. Vivek Kumar & Sh. Yogesh Yadav of Govt. College, Kosi who got training as Master Trainers at Indira Gandhi University Meerpur (Rewari) from 7<sup>th</sup> - 11<sup>th</sup>, June, 2022.

#### Day 1

The Programme commenced with the lightening ceremonial lamp by Principal Dr. Sudhir Kumar Yadav, Sh. Vivek Kumar, Associate Prof. and other senior staff members. After this Dr. Sudhir Yadav conducted a highly interacted session on "NEP 2020" and discussed about set up of multidisciplinary universities and colleges in India with at every district supported by multidisciplinary undergraduate courses and institutional autonomy. He also discussed the various fundamental principles of the policy such as fostering the unique capabilities of each student, flexibility of courses, no hard separation of disciplines, emphasis on conceptual understanding, creativity and critical thinking, extensive use of ICT, synergy in curriculum across all levels of education and lastly on light but tight regulatory framework to ensure integrity, transparency and resource efficiency.



Day 2

On second day workshop began with the session on Research vis-à-vis and NAAC by Sh. Vivek Kumar, Associate Professor of Economics. He discussed the need of Sustainable Development by mean of Research, development is necessary but not on the verge of ignorance of humanity and ethical values. He also talked on the NAAC and its need for the growth of a college with the seven criteria required for the assessment process, i.e. curricular aspects, Teaching learning and Evaluation, Research, Consultation & Extension, Infrastructure & Learning Resources, Student support & Progression, Governance, Leadership and Management and Innovation & Best practices.



Day 3

On Day three Sh. Yogesh Yadav, Assistant Professor in Botany talked on MOOCs (Massive Open Online Courses) and Provision of Entry & Exit in New Education policy in NEP 2020. He told the importance of MOOCs with respect to National Education Policy 2020. He talked on some important aspects of these courses such as characteristics, evolution, types, myths, some available MOOCs (such as SWAYAM), advantages and disadvantages for the same and discussed the parameters required for the formation of MOOCs for SWAYAM. He also discussed the provision of providing Certificate, Diploma, Degree and Degree with Research in New Education Policy. He also shared the draft of Curriculum prepared by Indira Gandhi University for coming session, Meerpur with the faculty members.

Lastly, there was open session for the queries of the staff members regarding NEP 2020, were taken by the all resource persons.

Sh. Sanjiv Kumar, Organising Secretary concluded the workshop with an interactive feedback session with the participants. Principal Dr. Sudhir Kumar congratulated all the participants and organisers for the successful completion of this workshop.

**(i)Topic of the National Seminar: -**

Literature reflects human experiences in all hues and shades. It not only portrays the warp and woof of society with its virtues and vices but also serves as a beacon of hope for the hopeless and depressed guiding their boat of life in right direction. Marginalization is a complex global problem that adversely affects societies across the world. The literary depiction of the marginalized lives has gain immense significance in modern era. The Spectrum of marginalization is so intricately designed, that when it gets unfold; its spectrum reflects all those wailing lives which get veiled by the intricate design of culture, power, and aesthetics.

The literature of the marginalized deals with the social problems of aborigines, women, Dalits, tribes, transgender, the black the minorities and so on. It throws light on the ways how they are suppressed and neglected by the people who are in power. Hence, Literature is resorted to by the marginalized writers to inject awareness among oppressed and marginalized people and raise a voice of protest or resistance against social, cultural, economic and political exclusion.

discrimination and injustice meted out to them for centuries. And such writings of revolt challenge the hegemonic and suppressive forces of society. Literature is used by marginalized writers not for "art' sake" but for "life sake". They are struggling hard to assert their identity and reclaim their human dignity and self respect. 
